Woods walk workshops are planned for 2021 and 2022 in three regions of NY:

- The Lake Champlain and Upper Hudson River Watershed to be hosted by the Northern and Southern Adirondack Chapters
- The Delaware River Watershed to be hosted by the Southern Tier Chapter
- Central Appalachia to be hosted by the Allegheny Foothills Chapter

We are excited about these programs and hope you will join in for the opportunity to learn about some different practices you can implement on your property to promote songbird inviting habitat. These woods walks will be led by Audubon staff on properties they selected to demonstrate management practices for promoting songbird habitat that have been implemented there. Furthermore, Audubon is in the process of certifying consulting foresters across NY through training, to give you additional access to qualified professionals to assist you in planning and implementing these practices.
